WELCOME

WHAT IS IT

Children's Worship is a time and place where children are taught what is worship, why we worship, and how to worship our GREAT God! We listen, watch, sing, dance, and play to honor and glorify Jesus!

PURPOSE

The main goal of Children's Worship is to help prepare your child to be lifelong worshippers with the whole church family. If your child is ready to stay with you for the duration of the service, they have graduated from Children's Worship!

HOW IT WORKS

- Children will begin the worship service in the sanctuary with you. They will typically be dismissed to Children's Worship right at the end of the scripture reading. They will gather in the back of the sanctuary and will retreat to the Fellowship Hall which is located directly under the sanctuary. The children will return during the final song of the service.
- Children's Worship is best suited for ages 3 years (and potty-trained)
 to Kindergarten. You know your child best. If you feel your first or
 second grader would benefit from attending on occasion, they are
 certainly welcome. We suggest that you attend Children's Worship
 with your child until they are comfortable with this new routine.
- There is no Children's Worship on the 1st and 5th Sundays.
 - The first Sunday of the month is when we celebrate the Lord's Supper. We find it incredibly important for our children to witness this sacrament even though they cannot partake of it yet.
 - The fifth Sunday of the month is when we set aside a specific time for our next generation to serve in the worship service. Giving opportunities for our children to serve shows them what it is to be a part of the body of Christ and exemplifies that they belong!
